From: THE CHANCELLOR MASTERS AND SCHOLARS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD ("University")

- 1. The University is the owner of the private land known as Radcliffe Square, which is edged red on the enclosed plan ("Land").
- 2. You do not have the University's permission to be on the Land for the purpose of an encampment. Your current use and occupation of the Land is not lawful and amounts to an act of TRESPASS.
- 3. Alternatively, any express or implied permission you have to be on the Land for the purpose of an encampment IS HEREBY WITHDRAWN.
- 4. You must leave the Land IMMEDIATELY and you must not return to the Land for the purpose of an encampment.
- 5. If you do not leave the Land by 7th July 2024 or if you return to the Land the University intends to bring court proceedings against you in which the University will seek the grant of a possession order.
- 6. If court proceedings are commenced the claim form and other court documents will be served before the court hearing by being displayed on the Land.
- 7. The University recommends that you take legal advice immediately if you have not already done so.
